## LET THERE BE LIGHT

Saint Daniel the Prophet Catholic Church was named an SRP Champion of Energy Efficiency due to the success of its recent lighting upgrade project, completed with help from the SRP Business Solutions Program.

Saint Daniel the Prophet Catholic Church is proud to have been named an SRP Champion of Energy Efficiency in the nonprofit category. “We are excited to be able to show off our trophy, and even more so that we have demonstrated to the community that we are good stewards of both the parish finances and the environment,” said Debbie Venezia, Parish Manager.

The parish’s successful energy-efficiency project encompassed a widespread replacement of outdated lighting and the addition of newer lighting technology throughout the interior and exterior of the 36-year-old campus.

With the electric bill being a major portion of the church’s budget and the parish’s constant search for ways to cut costs while continuing to provide worthwhile programs and services for parishioners, Father Thaddeus McGuire and Venezia were very interested in the SRP Business Solutions Program.

## SAVING ENERGY AND REDUCING COSTS

During the project, the church campus underwent a comprehensive lighting retrofit that included replacing old T12 lighting with new efficient LED lighting on the interior; providing superior visibility outside; and adding spot lighting to improve the overall aesthetics of special religious artifacts.

The total project cost for Saint Daniel’s was \$3,486 after receiving a rebate totaling \$10,934 from SRP. Saint Daniel’s electric bill was 26% less than it was the previous year, and they will see an estimated 46% annual energy savings overall.

## BENEFITS BEYOND MONTHLY SAVINGS

The visibility of precious religious statues and paintings was greatly improved by the lighting upgrade. Venezia noted, “Some people even thought the stations of the cross were new, but they had been there the whole time and now they were just easier to see — and in great detail!”

The pinnacle of the award-winning lighting project was that they were able to light up the church steeple for the very first time.



## SAVING POWER AND MONEY

**Project:** Saint Daniel the Prophet Catholic Church

In addition, the new lights emit substantially less heat than the old lights. Another benefit is the huge improvement to campus safety. The exterior illumination makes the campus much safer for everyone, including children attending evening classes and elderly parishioners with impaired vision. With newer technology, maintenance costs will drop by as much as 90%, and lamp power has decreased by 65–90%.

Most importantly, the money saved through the rebate program can go back into the parish. “First, it has reduced our electric bill, so the money we have been able to save has allowed us to use those funds in other more pastoral areas. Second, we’ve provided a better setting in which our people can worship,” said Father McGuire.
